### JOB PURPOSE

The job holder will provide leadership and technical oversight in the Western Region on Care and Treatment program to ensure contractual obligations are met. He/she will support in developing strategies to scale up delivery of comprehensive quality care and treatment services for HIV positive key and priority population at Drop-in centers/community level, establish and implement community follow up mechanisms to enhance adherence to and retention on care and treatment, develop, pilot and scale up differentiated care models for key and priority populations and develop mechanisms for strengthening systems for laboratory networking and nutritional support, offer technical support for laboratory external quality assurance systems and commodity management at Drop-in centers/community level among other deliverables.

### KEY ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide overall technical/administrative leadership for HIV/TB care and treatment services among key and priority populations in Western region.
- Take lead in designing effective differentiated care models for ART delivery at the community level
- Provide oversight for treatment services at the Drop-in centers/ static site level
- Prepare monthly, quarterly and other relevant reports as may be required by the organization and Donors and submit to the Regional Director in a timely manner
- Provide leadership in the periodic project performance reviews in the region
- Create and maintain external relationships at sub-county, county and regional level
- Participate in relevant National and County Care and Treatment TWGs
- Coordinate development, implementation and monitoring of the care and treatment work plans in collaboration with the regional care team
- Provide continuous mentorship, capacity building and support supervision to care and treatment coordinators and staff within the region and responsible for field monitoring and supervision of program activities on a monthly basis to ensure alignment with set strategies, quality and achievement of targets.
- Line manager to care and treatment staff and responsible for their budget approvals and liquidations, timesheet and leave approvals.
- Work with research department to identify potential studies for care and treatment program and other programs emerging in the region and utilize them for research and policy formulation.

- Set goals and objectives for regional Care and Treatment programs in line with LVCT Health's vision and strategy, outlining expected results and tracking performance.
- Support Quality Assurance/Quality Improvement initiatives in the region and assisting the teams develop a quality management plan
- Provide leadership and direction to the program and regional teams on documentation, dissemination and utilization of LVCT Health work and other priority documents among staff and key stakeholders in the region.

## **JOB REQUIREMENTS**

- Must possess a Bachelor's Degree in Medicine (MBChB) with 5 years post internship experience, Master's degree in public Health/Social Sciences or a related field will be an added advantage.
- Experience in HIV/TB Care and treatment training and working in a CCC will be an added advantage
- Hands on clinical experience in HIV service delivery
- Possess relevant working experience in donor funded public health program is an added advantage
- Research experience, proposal and abstract writing will be a distinctive advantage
- Excellent facilitation, mentorship, team building and coordination skills
- Ability to work in a complex project implementation environment with multiple tasks, short deadlines and intense pressure
- Key population programming experience is an added advantage
- Ability to work well with others and to develop and maintain relationships with project staff, donors, sub-contractors and other partners
- Clear understanding and experience working with MOH and public health systems especially at county level
- Ability to identify problems, design interventions and oversee their implementation
- Must demonstrate excellent oral and written communication skills
